Sustainability Strategy

Entrenuity has provided entrepreneurship education, training, and resources for aspiring entrepreneurs, educators, and organization leaders for over 20 years. The key to our **sustainability** as an organization has been successfully implementing **multiple** strategies for generating revenue:

- Fee-based *entrepreneurship programming* for youth and adults locally, nationally, and internationally.
- Fee-based *training and resources* for entrepreneurship educators (teachers, community leaders, youth advisors, nonprofit leaders, etc.) locally, nationally, and internationally.
- Long-term relationships with investors, corporate sponsors, and business partners, building an influential, diverse, and *committed investor network*.
- Integrating for-profit business initiatives to add revenue streams, while providing jobs and learning opportunities to program participants.
- Secured \$2.3M in gifts and financing to purchase and renovate historically significant building in the South Loop for Entrenuity headquarters, thereby acquiring asset and increasing capacity for additional revenue-generating opportunities.






Income History


